Event: British Ladies and Girls Trials Championship Round 6

Date: 8th September 2019

Announcement: The Guisborough & District Motor Cycle Club Ltd will hold a round of the above championship on 8th September 2019 which will be held under the national Sporting Code of the Auto Cycle Union, the trials Standing regulations, ACU Belle Trailers Ladies and Girls Championship regulations, together with these supplementary regulations and any final instructions issued in accordance with TSR 1.

Eligibility All riders must hold a current ACU / SACU Trials Registration Card. Or an ACU / SACU competition licence. Riders from other FMN must produce a licence and start permission confirming insurance issued from their FMN or pay the fee according to the insurance declaration form.

Course: The course will be on private land and consist of natural terrain. It will be 1.5 miles in length. There will be twelve sections incorporating 3 routes through each section. The number of laps three. Sections must be ridden in numerical order.

Venue: Charltons, 1 mile from Guisborough on the A171 Whitby road. **Post Code TS14 6PX.**

Start Time: 10:30 at one minute intervals. **Time Limit:** 5 Hours **Marking:** As Per TSR 22B **NON-STOP**

Classes of Rider: Riders will be grouped in classes as per the Championship Standing Regulations.

Results: Provisional results will be displayed within 30 mins of the event finishing and subsequently displayed on the clubs website.

Awards: Awards will be presented after the event to 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each Class

Entry Fee: Entries to be received by the Secretary of the meeting on or before the 18th August 2019 together with the entry fee of £25 made payable to **Guisborough & District Motor Cycle Club Ltd.** Two stamped addressed envelopes or an Email Address must be provided. Entry fees will only be refunded if the event is cancelled.

Assistants: One assistant per rider, who must sign on and pay a fee of £1

Cut out Device: All machines must have cut out devices rigidly connected to the rider by lanyard (max length 1 metre)
